RULES FOR ST. MARY AND ST. GABRIEL CHURCH, STOKE GABRIEL SIX BELL RINGING COMPETITION

For the St Mary and St. Gabriel Perpetual Shield presented by E.O.H. Hill and "Bill" Hine Memorial Cup presented by Mrs W. Hine

- 1. Two Ringers may be borrowed provided they do not ring Treble or Tenor.
- 2. The Judges' decision shall be final.
- 3. Teams are to ring the peal known as "Sixty on Thirds".
- 4. The duration of the peal including Rise and Fall must not be less than fifteen minutes.
- 5. No practise will be allowed for this competition.
- 6. The Entrance Fee will be £6.00 per team.
- 7. The Church Council and Bell Ringers will not be held responsible for any accidents that may occur.
- 8. Teas will be available.

RULES FOR THE ARTHUR SEYMOUR MEMORIAL TROPHY

To be held this year at **COLLATON ST MARY**

- 1. Rules as shown above include
- 2. £6 entrance fee for each team AND
- 3. The trophy will be held by the winner for twelve months.
- 4. The winner shall have the option of arranging the competition the following year at a tower of their choosing.
- 5. No team shall compete in their home tower.
- 6. All competitors must be regular church service ringers of the tower they represent.
- 7. The tower holding the competition will not be responsible for any accident or injury to a ringer taking part.

RULES FOR ST. MARY AND ST. GABRIEL CHURCH, STOKE GABRIEL SIX BELL RINGING COMPETITION – DEVELOPMENT SECTION

The aim of this event is to encourage and have fun. These rules are a guide, with the main theme concentrating on the spirit of the competition – the competition organisers reserve the right to disqualify any teams seen to be abusing the nature of this development section.

- Teams should consist of 6 ringers who are regular service ringers for that tower.
- Where a tower wishes to enter two teams, it is suggested that there should be at least 10 ringers.
- Teams may borrow one ringer, but not to ring treble or tenor.
- Entry will be £6 for each team.
- This competition will involve top ringing only: there will be no rising or lowering
- The judges' decision will be final.
- Certificates will be awarded to all competing teams.
- This competition will be timed, with ringing commencing at 3pm.
- Teams will be expected to ring HALF a peal of SIXTY ON THIRDS. They may ring the first or second half.
- Teams will be allowed ONE minute of rounds to settle, and then must start changing. Judging will commence at the first change and cease once the bells get back into rounds.
- There will be a maximum limit of 10 minutes for the change ringing and a suggested minimum of 5 minutes. Please return the bells back on their stays once ringing has been completed.
